Screenings and sand will cost approximately \$15,000 to \$16,000 minimum. Up to \$5,000 for the compression. No quote for the paver. Kira looking to see if it can be donated. \$10,000 can be spent. The only cost we should have is for the sand. They will bring it in, dump it and we can spread it with our harrow.

Facilities:

Scott wanted a conversation with Dianne and Kira re setting a date for delivery of the screenings. Need volunteers, organizing lunch, work party before the screenings can be put down. Must be done at the very least the day before, early morning. Need to put this matter aside for now. Phone call to take place in the next day or so.
