#### COMMITTEE REPORTS

Dangerous Dogs:

- Last meeting Kristen raised concerns about dangerous dogs.
- Ted picked up some brochures on dogs in the park from CRD but they were not what he hoped for and not appropriate.
- Ted would like to create a brochure with the by-laws in it.
- Colleen Long, CRD Coordinator of Volunteers would like to organize a day with the horses to hand out brochures to dog walkers.
- Claire said that the police recommend taking a picture of the dog, its tag and its owner if a dog behaved aggressively toward you or your horse. You can also report aggressive dogs to the Saanich Pound at 250 475-4321.
- Joanne would like to put something out to the membership saying what to do if you are attached by a dog. Lara would include this in a message to the membership.
- Lara pointed out that both horse people and dog people sometimes violate the bylaws.
- Joanne suggested that the CRD might but up a sign saying dogs need to be leashed. Lara said this was suggested before and CRD was reluctant.
- Ted will continue the conversation with Colleen Long.

- **HCBC Core Funding** Need a project complete with estimates i.e. painting of the out buildings. Applications due April 15, 2017.

- Provincial Government Grants. Get on the BC Gaming Branch's Casino List.
- Used Tack Sale twice a year (spring & fall)
- **EBLES Logo** we need to "brand" ourselves. Could have a contest for someone to design same or we could pay a company to design one for us. Cost is between \$5 and \$70. See https//www.fwerr.com/nashagen
- Once we have a logo, we can go to a supplier who has blank stock on hand i.e. ball caps, sweat shirts etc. We can advertise these goods for sale on our website, get our logo put on the item and get person to pay for same. Our

fee is added to the cost of the goods. Need to work out a deal with the supplier.
