### **TREASURER'S REPORT**

### FACILITIES

- Kristen will oversee the clean up or resurrection of the shelter. She will determine what can be salvaged.
- At the work party, an attempt was made to rake the round pen by hand but it was not reasonably possible. At the next work party the tractor will be used to do it.
- The Appy club would like gravel put over the board that blocks the turtles out of the sand ring so that horses will not trip over it.
- Kristen will determine when to hold a work party to rake the fallen leaves off the sand ring. Joanne will make a poster announcing the upcoming leaf raking party and directing people to contact Kristen for details.

### RENTALS

• Claire reported that there were 10 ring or round pen rentals in 2017 that generated \$1650, which was comprised of \$950 in ring rentals and \$700 in participant fees from 140 participants. See attached report for more details.

### CORRESPONDANCE

- Lara received an email response from Marc Solomon saying CRD does not have money for any projects, such as moving the bulletin board and providing gravel for the tie stalls.
- There was a Facebook discussion about whether or not riders need to pick up manure dropped on trails. The answer is no.

### FUND RAISING

- Claire will organize a used tack sale, possibly for April 2. She will try to find an indoor ring to hold it in.
- Claire has looked into applying for casino money. She will review what she found, look into it further and bring it up at the January meeting.

- Lara sent out a notice about the draw for the \$25 gift certificate for renewing EBLES membership before Jan 1, 2018.
- The issue of whether or not it would be possible to continue operate with decreased rentals was discussed. It was decided that it is possible.
