# TREASURER'S REPORT:

-OPENING BALANCE March 13th: \$10,688.64

-REVENUES: \$465.00 membership e transfers,

\$640.65 from Event Bright

\$3.08 over payment

-TOTAL REVENUE: \$1108.93

-EXPENSES: \$71.51 to Dianne for supplies (screws, nails, brackets for ring repair, etc.)

\$1.50 service charge

-TOTAL EXPENSES: \$73.01

-CLOSING BALANCE: \$ 11,724.56

-EXPECTED REVENUES: \$30.00 membership expected

-EXPECTED EXPENSES: work party snacks \$25.00

hydro bill approx \$30.00 water bill approx \$400.00

-Projected cost for round pen project as follows: \$5000.00 materials, No quote yet for labour (Tidy line). Anticipating at least \$7500.00 for labour posts. Potentially labour costs could deplete our cash reserves. Application for grant application needs to be in by April 30<sup>th</sup>.

Jenny will calculate projected income from this year's scheduled events, redo the budget which includes projected income for the year, and distribute this information to executive to help with decision making re round pen. Need to establish how much cash reserves to maintain in bank above the expected budget. \$3500 was suggested as an appropriate amount to have available for unexpected issues.

## MEMBERSHIP:

- -Draw for those who joined before March 31: Using random number generator-Shana Johnston is the winner of the draw

#### **FACILITIES:**

REPORT on April 5<sup>th</sup> work party:

- -there were some new volunteers helping
- -weed whacking was done, leaves were raked, concession area was cleaned, and the board on small ring where sand leaking out was repaired.

WORK THAT STILL NEEDS TO BE DONE is as follows:

- -A second board in small ring, and a board in main ring where sand leaking out will need to be replaced at a later date
- Also for next work party, gutters need to be measured for gutter guards. Gutter guards need to be installed (ideally the foam drop in ones that we can install easily ourselves). Andy will research sources and obtain costs for foam insert gutter guards
- -replacing rotten fence boards is too large a project to accomplish with a single work party, may be scheduled to be done separately with Exec members, or over multiple future dates

Poker Ride June 14th:

- -Need to start advertising and collecting prizes. Use Google docs to track and document donors and prize collection.
- -Advertising as previously on social media and by putting up posters (use previous posters with dates modified. Dianne will get posters printed as well as doner forms. Jennie will contact local veterinarians. Put up posters at Saanich fairgrounds. Need to recruit volunteers- Laura will do trail class and recruit volunteers from her barn.

- -Ideally have people fill in membership form for Poker Ride on line in advance, so less congestion when riders arrive. Consider \$5.00 discount on Poker Ride for advanced registration

Difficulty getting quote for fence pounding, contractors are busy and not returning our calls.

Grant must be in by April 30<sup>th</sup>. Work needs to be done by mid June.

- -Report on the condition of the trails: all open, some are muddy. Lots of water in the fields. 2 small trees down on unofficial trails that horses can step over. These will not be cleared as they are not official trails.
- -Proposed to approach Stewart about clearing the fallen trees on the unofficial trails
