# **FACILITIES:**

- repair areas where sand is leaking out of ring,

- need to measure gutters and length of gutters (with intension of purchasing gutter guards)

- thorough clean of concession.
- measure the lengths of fence boards that require replacing and inventory what we have to figure out what needs to be ordered. The boards will be replaced and painted at a later date when the weather is dry. (Andy already obtained a quote for \$300.00 if 33 boards are needed)
- -Still need to build mounting block, dispose of scrap lumbar after build mounting blocks, but is not critical to do prior to upcoming ring rentals. Can be completed at a later date

TASKS TO BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO APRIL 5<sup>th</sup> work party:

- -We do not have any treated boards for sand leak repair. We will need to buy wood. Diane will purchase the boards, purchase brackets and nails. Do BEFORE the work party
- -Home Depot has drop in gutter guards. Verify sizing
- -Andy will relook at section of fence in small ring that is compromised.
- get coffee and tea snacks for work party- approved to purchase

OTHER PROJECTS: -needs signs made instructing people to pick up manure. Ask Stewart to make a sign for us. Place signs at each entrance gate to riding rings

Claire attended funding seminar for HCBC/grant availability. HCBC Core grant is under equipment/infrastructure umbrella. This grant covers 75% of a project up to \$5000.00 (includes arena upgrades . Must have applications in by April 30<sup>th</sup>. A lease agreement, budget, a letter of support from property owner, and report at end of project as well as all receipts are required.

Jenny is still spearheading the upgrade to the round pen and will redo the budget. Tentatively would be a post and rail project. A post pounder would be required.

There is also an Education Grant available through HCBC that can be used for in classroom learning, or demonstration. This grant can provide a maximum of \$500 and could be applied to a working equitation clinic. To qualify for this grant, EBLES would need to apply for it in advance, get approval, then send in final report and receipts.
